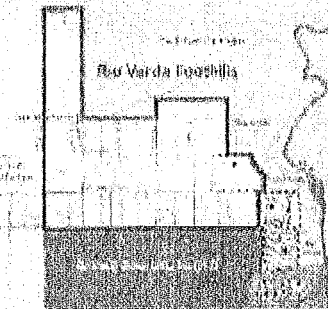
We would also like to be apart of large scale wildfire maintenance since our area burned approximately 23,000 acres and the McDowell Mountain Regional Park in July of 1995.

Let me know your thoughts on what we can do accomplish our goals!

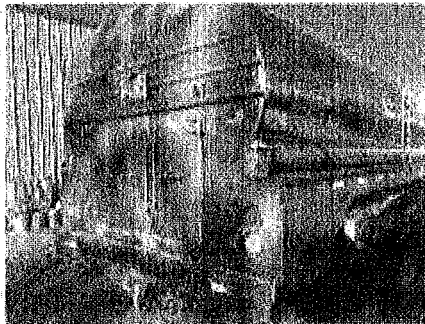

I spoke with you a few weeks ago on the telephone, I am trying to find out how Damon Bruns, owner of Dynamite Water LLC and his garage property Granite Mountain Investments LLC can become a volunteer fire substation for storing the water trucks; the trucks have adapters which link up to our rural metro fire trucks.
